

Do you enjoy learning about wildlife, but can't see too many animals outside?

Create a wildlife-friendly garden! This will attract birds, squirrels, bats, butterflies, and other creatures. In Ontario, there are only a few things you need for your backyard or a balcony.

Ask your parents for help in gathering these items...

Food: e.g. Native Ontario plants, seeds, berries, nectar flowers



Water: e.g. Birdbath, pond, water fountain



Shelter and hiding spots: e.g. Bushes, trees, birdhouse, rock pile



Places to raise young: e.g. Birdhouse, shrubs, trees, nesting box, bat box
